

## PUBLIC STATEMENT

## FM FREQUENCY REFARMING UPDATE

The Malawi Communications Regulatory Authority (MACRA) wishes to inform the public that it has now commenced implementing resolutions made at the Annual Broadcasters Conference in December 2022 to extend the moratorium on the issuance of FM frequencies for 12 months. This is to effect a total overhaul of the FM band to find a long-lasting solution to the scarcity of frequencies between the region's 87.5 MHz to 108 MHz band allotment.

## STEPS TAKEN TO DATE

On 12<sup>th</sup> January 2023, MACRA met the technical personnel and engineers from all broadcasting stations at the Bingu International Conference Centre in Lilongwe where the following issues were agreed upon:

- i. To conduct frequent meetings and update broadcasters on progress made.
- ii. To collect relevant data required for the project.
- iii. To assess the suitability of the current broadcasting sites.
- iv. To determine Optimal Transmission Sites for the Nation.
- v. To produce coverage maps for the identified sites.
- vi. To design a standard FM Network for a nation.
- vii. To produce the Implementation Strategy for the New FM Plan.
- viii. To produce recommended specifications of transmission equipment.
  - ix. To recommend New Technologies to be Used in FM Networks.
  - x. To Produce Scenarios on how best the FM network can be utilized.
- xi. To explore the reuse of frequencies by each broadcaster as much as possible.
- xii. To determine the number of frequencies that can be assigned at the identified Sites with consideration of 200 kHz Channel Separation.
